**Notes:** Any family needing assistance with student supplies should contact a guidance counselor at registration. Any student preferring to use a tablet stylus on his/her iPad may supply one. Students may also choose to bring screen wipes to keep in lockers for personal use. Supplies that are lost or exhausted may need to be replaced later in the year. Choose a small backpack. Large gym bags or rolling backpacks do not fit in hall lockers. Students transporting items from locker to gym mid-day must use a small drawstring bag or plastic bag.

### SMS PE Attire

6th Grade PE (fall/daily)- Students do not change clothing. Wear comfortable school clothes and tennis shoes.

7th Grade PE (spring)- Students change to shorts or sweatpants and a solid color t-shirt with name written on front and also must wear tennis shoes. No zippers or buttons on any PE clothing. Clothing must meet general school dress code guidelines.

8th Grade PE (all year/high school credit class)- Students will wear a short sleeved solid gray or ash t-shirt, blue or black elastic waistband shorts. Students will be required to write their names on the front of the shirt to identify it as a PE uniform. Students may wear sweatshirts or sweatpants over their uniforms. No buttons or zippers on any PE clothing. PE uniforms must meet general school dress code guidelines. Students must wear tennis shoes.
